

Project Description: Arcoplast Antimicrobial Ceiling Liners

This cooler ceiling was our second Arcoplast Ceiling Liner project for Land O'Lakes in Spencer Wisconsin. This ceiling, comprised mostly of panels 8' wide x 15'-8" long, was on the 3rd floor of the building. We maneuvered the panels into the building through a knock-out panel on the 3rd floor with a telescoping forklift. The cooler was sealed off from the rest of the facility with temporary walls to allow production to operate continually throughout the duration of the project. This was a direct attached ceiling liner system over the existing concrete structure. The ceiling panels are set in adhesive and mechanically fastened around the perimeters. All seams/joints are then hermetically sealed with the unique Arcoplast batten cover system. This Arcoplast ceiling will ensure Land O'Lakes a clean, safe cooler for many years to come.

Originally (back in the early 1920s) Land O'Lakes was an organization by the name of Minnesota Cooperative Creameries Association.
