



Project Description: Arcoplast Antimicrobial Wall Liners

During the spring of 2005 ICS completed a challenging Arcoplast project for John Morrell & Co. A 130' long x 16' high glazed block wall in a processing area that had heaved and bulged over the years was in need of a face-lift. The wall needed to be furred out before we could line the walls with Arcoplast Antimicrobial wall liners. The plant's vigorous production and sanitation schedule governed our project schedule. We had a 24 to 36 hour window each weekend to unload, set-up, work, tear-down, clean-up, and reload.

This was our second Arcoplast project for John Morrell & Co. in Sioux City. The first was also completed during tight weekend schedules. We expect to continue providing Arcoplast Antimicrobial installations for this facility for many years to come.
